<b>Participation in task</b>	Group member participated fully and was <b>always</b> on task in class	Group member participated most of the time and was on task <b>most</b> of the time.	Group member participated but <b>wasted time regularly</b> or was rarely on task.	Group member <b>did not participate</b> , and they wasted time, or worked on unrelated material.
<b>Leadership</b>	Group member assumed <b>leadership in appropriate ways</b> when necessary by helping the group stay on track, encouraging group participation, posing solutions to problems, and having a positive attitude.	Group member <b>sometimes</b> assumed leadership in an appropriate way.	Group member usually allowed others to assume leadership, OR alternatively, often dominated the group. <b>Cooperation with others</b>	Group <b>member treated others respectfully</b> and shared the workload fairly.	Group member <b>usually</b> treated others respectfully and shared the workload fairly.	Group member <b>sometimes treated others disrespectfully</b> or did not share the workload fairly.	Group member <b>often treated others disrespectfully</b> or did not share the workload fairly.
<b>Time Management</b>	Group member completed assigned tasks <b>on time</b> .	Group member <b>usually</b> completed assigned tasks on time and did not hold up progress on the projects because of incomplete work.	Group member <b>often did not</b> complete assigned tasks on time, and held up completion of project work.	Group member <b>did not complete most of the assigned tasks</b> on time and often forced the group to make last-minute adjustments and changes to accommodate missing work.
